About our Program

All lessons are taught by an American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor and follow the American Red Cross Learn-to-Swim guidelines. The sessions offered are all designed to give students a positive learning experience as they are introduced to the water and learn basic personal water safety information and skills. In this beginner level, elementary aquatic skills are taught, with students focusing on development of positive attitudes, good swimming habits and safe practices in and around the water.
